

PROGRAM PROCEDURE:

For new installations, **default** the unit first so as to erase the factory programmed test remote from the unit.

TO DEFAULT:

Press in the LEARN button for approx 10seconds. The unit starts to beep. When the beeping sounds continuously both channels are defaulted.



Press and hold in

LEARN Ch2:STEP 3

Press the LEARN button again [1x short beep, & R2 LED goes on as well as relay 2 latches in]



LEARN Ch1:STEP 1

Press the LEARN button in once. [1x short beep, & R1 LED goes on as well as relay 1 latches in]



LEARN Ch2:..... STEP 4

Press the required button on each new remote control one at a time to learn in the coded signals to Ch2 [2x Beeps when it learns in]



Max 64 remotes per channel

LEARN Ch1:..... STEP 2

Press the required button on each new remote control one at a time to learn in the coded signals to Ch1 [2x Beeps when it learns in]



Max 64 remotes per channel

Repeat STEP 1 to 4, for Learning in Channels 3 and 4.

The unit Exits by pressing the learn button once Channel 4 was selected.



Exit by pressing once after Ch4 was selected

RELAY MODE SETTINGS:

Select one of the three (3) jumper settings for each relay channel. The Relay mode jumpers set the unit to switch the relay closure time. We recommend the following settings be used as a guide line:-

- > 1 seconds Gate and garage door installations.
- > 3 seconds Remote Panic alarm installations.
- > Latching / Unlatching Switching on/off lights or key-switch arm / diss-arming of alarms.

PROGRAM THE RECEIVER USING A MASTER REMOTE:

Programming from a dedicated remote is useful in that you do not need to open the receiver housing in order to learn in extra remotes. Programming can be done using what we term a "MASTER REMOTE". The master remote will be the first remote that is programmed into the unit after the unit has been defaulted. The "Master Remote" always sounds a double beep when received by the receiver unit.

Procedure as follows applies to each Relay Channel individually:

- 1. Continuously Transmit the MASTER REMOTE for the relay channel and listen to the buzzer. When the buzzer stops beeping you must, Quickly stop transmitting. This takes approx 10 seconds.
- 2. Learn in each new remote one by one. >The unit beeps when each new signal is leant in.
- 3. To Exit from Program mode...Transmit the MASTER REMOTE. > A Long beep sounds.
- 4. If you do not exit with the **MASTER REMOTE** it will automatically exit after about 30 seconds of inactivity.

Product note: Up to 64 remotes can be learn't. If you require more memory, please enquire about our extended memory capacity unit, or enquire about another product in our line card called the :- COMPLEX-RX Receiver which can learn up to 1000 remotes.
